The AGF advocates the interests of families and promotes the dialogue and cooperation of family organisations. It expresses the common concerns of its member associations and is an active partner in politics and society:

- conferences and expert discussions with representatives from politics and science, civil-social organisations and the media;
- statements and position papers, press releases and brochures;
- discussions with members of parliament and persons responsible in politics.

The AGF supports the communication on the national as well as the European level.

It is a member of the German Youth Institute e. V. (DJI), the Federal Foundation “Mother and Child – Protection of Unborn Life” and the Confederation of Family Organisations in the European Union (COFACE).

Family as a Social Task

Family policy is a central field of social policy. The AGF views supporting for families as a political cross section task which includes all policy areas.

The AGF strives for the improvement of the basic conditions of families in Germany and Europe. This implicates the financial relief for families as well as the development and improvement of family, child and care friendly infrastructure.

Important issues in the work of the AGF are, among others, combating child poverty, the reduction of the value added tax on child products, as well as the areas of education and health.

Due to the fact that national policy and policy on the EU level increasingly interlock with each other, the AGF is strengthening its activities on the European level. It participates in the consultation on family-political issues with transnational effects and introduces positions into European politics.
